

# File Antivirus: Files needs to be excluded from being scanned by eScan monitor

Open the eScan protection center > File antivirus > Objects > Exclude by Mask > Add/Delete > enter the file name > Add > Ok

If this does not help (If the files still being scanned by monitor), you can exclude the file using registry, Go to HKEY\_LOCAL\_MACHINE\SOFTWARE\MicroWorld\eScan for Windows\MwMonitor\ProcExclusionsf Create a new DWORD and rename it as the file name to be excluded and set the DWORD value to 2.

**This files will also exclude from the Quick Scan Your Systems also.**
